Thank you for your interest in our Playschool 2010 Summer Program. If you decide that Playschool is the ideal program for the child/ren that you care for, the following steps are to be taken to register:

### STEP ONE:

**Schedule an appointment.** Upon scheduling an appointment, an application will be mailed to you with your appointment confirmation.

### STEP TWO:

#### **Bring the following to your appointment**

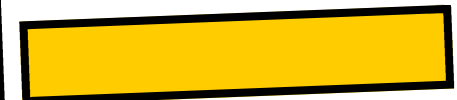
- A completed application (to be in hand at the time of your appointment),
- Participants Birth Certificate
- Parent/Guardians Photo I.D
- A current copy of your child's health insurance card.
- Your initial deposit for the first session for each child enrolled *payments accepted in the form of Cash, MasterCard, Visa, Personal Check Money Order.*
- If you are a voucher recipient, a current voucher is required at the time of your appointment with the Playschool Summer Program Information reflected on the voucher. *Parent fees are due according to the payment schedule (listed in the Policy and Fee Related Items on page 2 of the application).*
- If a Third Party is paying on your behalf, you will need to present a scholarship letter from the organization *stating the sessions that have been approved for your child, the amount the organization will be paying, and contact information of the representative assigned to your family.*
- If you are paying out of pocket, please keep in mind that session balances are due according to the payment schedule (listed in the Policy and Fee Related Items on page 2 of the application).

Summer Playschool is an urban program serving approximately 300 ethnically diverse children, ages (K2) 5-14, from East Boston and the surrounding communities.

A low staff to child ratio of 1 to 6 provides as much individual attention as possible to each child. The culturally diverse and multi-lingual school age and summer camp staff reflects the diversity of the children of East Boston, and its surrounding communities.



Playschool offers a wide variety of opportunities for children to continue learning throughout the summer months.

Learning opportunities include educationally based field trips to a variety of museums and historical landmarks, educational computer games, multi-cultural exploration, reading programs, social development curriculum, environmental awareness activities, health/wellness curriculum, and



so much more.

In addition, Playschool campers will visit different state park each week. Playschool also participates in AGM's cultural day, which provides funding for educational field trips The Constitution, Museum of Science, Museum of Fine Arts, Children's Museum, and Zoo New England.
